We are looking for outgoing, self-motivated, cheerful people to staff all of our departments, who enjoy interfacing with the public, who get along with other friendly faces, and welcome the physical demands that each position requires. We offer flexible scheduling, though we generally require each employee to work one or two weekend shifts each week. We're open between 8 AM and 6 PM from April to November, with just 10 weeks in spring in which we stay open till 7 PM.

Annual Department

Positions in the Annual Department are short-term, generally spanning late April through July, and include working with customers and maintaining annual flowers. A cursory knowledge of annual flowers is preferred.

Nursery Department

Nursery positions generally run from late March to late Summer, though many Nursery employees stay on through October, with a few staying on till late November. These positions include merchandising and maintaining trees and shrubs, and lots of customer interaction, all of which require miles of walking each day, and a fair amount of pushing carts and lifting up to 50lbs. Some Nursery employees run front loaders, forklifts and skid steers, but all are required to help customers choose the right shrubs and trees for their sites. Experience with plants is helpful but we will train anyone who is eager to learn. If plants don't excite you, the Nursery Department isn't for you.

Inside Merchandise Sales

Position includes pricing and displaying hardgoods in the store, and well as guiding customers. We will Train. Some positions are seasonal and some are year-round. Starts in April.

Loaders

Position includes loading products into customer vehicles, unloading product as it arrives, as well as maintaining a clean appearance throughout the grounds, both inside the store and out. Some Loaders operate front loaders and forklifts, though there's plenty of work for our under 18 staffers who don't. Starts in March or April. Some positions are seasonal, some continue into fall or winter.

Cashiers

During the spring rush, our check-out area has to be the busiest place on earth. Our cashiers also direct customers and callers to the appropriate department, help with plant care, and work to maintain a neat work environment. Positions start in April, and are either seasonal or continue through most of the year.

Perennials

Positions in our Perennial Department start in April each year, with some being short term (into July) and others continuing into late October. Employees unload merchandise and maintain perennial plants and help guide our customers to the plant that is right for their spot. Experience gardening with perennials is helpful but we will train anyone with a passion for learning about these diverse plants.
